# **BISON MEN'S CHORUS**

The BISON MEN'S CHORUS was organized in September 1985 in response to a perceived need at the University of Manitoba. The opportunity of participation in a choral organization such as this permits students, faculty and staff, as well as alumni and other men from the community, to interact in an exciting musical experience. Dr. Larry Patterson, organizer and conductor, is an associate professor of Music Education and brings many years of choral experience to this chorus. A variety of repertoire is performed including traditional music for male chorus as well as contemporary settings of folk music, jazz, Broadway musicals and commissioned works. Auditions are not required.

The BISON MEN'S CHORUS has been well received in concert appearances including the Manitoba Legislature, several area churches, the University of Manitoba campus and the University of North Dakota, and a joint appearance with the Winnipeg Male Chorus. The BISON MEN'S CHORUS was also an invited choir at the Gala Concert celebrating the 10th anniversary of the Manitoba Choral Association.

The **BISON MEN'S CHORUS** was made possible by a grant covering the initial three years of operation provided by the University of Manitoba Academic Development Fund. The **CHORUS** is limited to a membership of sixty. Rehearsals are held Tuesdays, 5:00 - 6:30 p.m. at the Faculty of Education auditorium.
