PACIFIC INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL OF MALE CHOIRS VANCOUVER, B.C. JULY 7-10, 1990

The University of Manitoba BISON MEN'S CHORUS has received the distinction of being invited to perform at the Pacific International Festival of Male Choirs to be held at Canada Place in Vancouver. This prestigious event will be host to 20 choirs representing 14 countries, as well as The Kings Singers, the United States Army Chorus, and the Dudaryk Choir from Russia. The BISON MEN'S CHORUS is one of five Canadian choirs to be selected by an international artistic advisory council. Each chorus will perform a one hour concert during the Festival and participate in the combined performance of a commissioned work for male chorus and the C.B.C. Vancouver Orchestra. This latter will be conducted by the eminent American Conductor, John Nelson.

This event is being hosted by the Honorable David Lam, Lieutenant Governor of British Columbia and has received substantial funding from the B.C. Government. It is a singular honour for the BISON MEN'S CHORUS to have been invited to represent the Province of Manitoba, the City of Winnipeg and the University of Manitoba in this international festival. The CHORUS is pleased to be able to accept the invitation and eagerly anticipates the cultural and educational opportunities experience this experience will provide, as well as the higher profile that this event will bring to the University, the City and the Province of Manitoba.
