Organized with an initial three year grant from the President's Academic Development Fund, the Chorus has performed in a wide variety of concerts and appearances including community service events, university and alumni functions, and international festivals. They have just released their third album entitled "Brown and Gold".

The Chorus has been heard on local and national radio broadcasts. It is comprised of 50-60 members in any given year, representing undergraduate and graduate students, faculty, staff, alumni and other men from the Winnipeg community. Dr. Larry Patterson, professor of Music Education at the University of Manitoba, has been the chorus conductor since its beginning. While Dr. Patterson is on study leave in 1996, Reno Gerl, is the associate conductor. A graduate of the University of Manitoba, Reno is the music director at Windsor Park Collegiate. Conrad Hoeppner is the accompanist.
